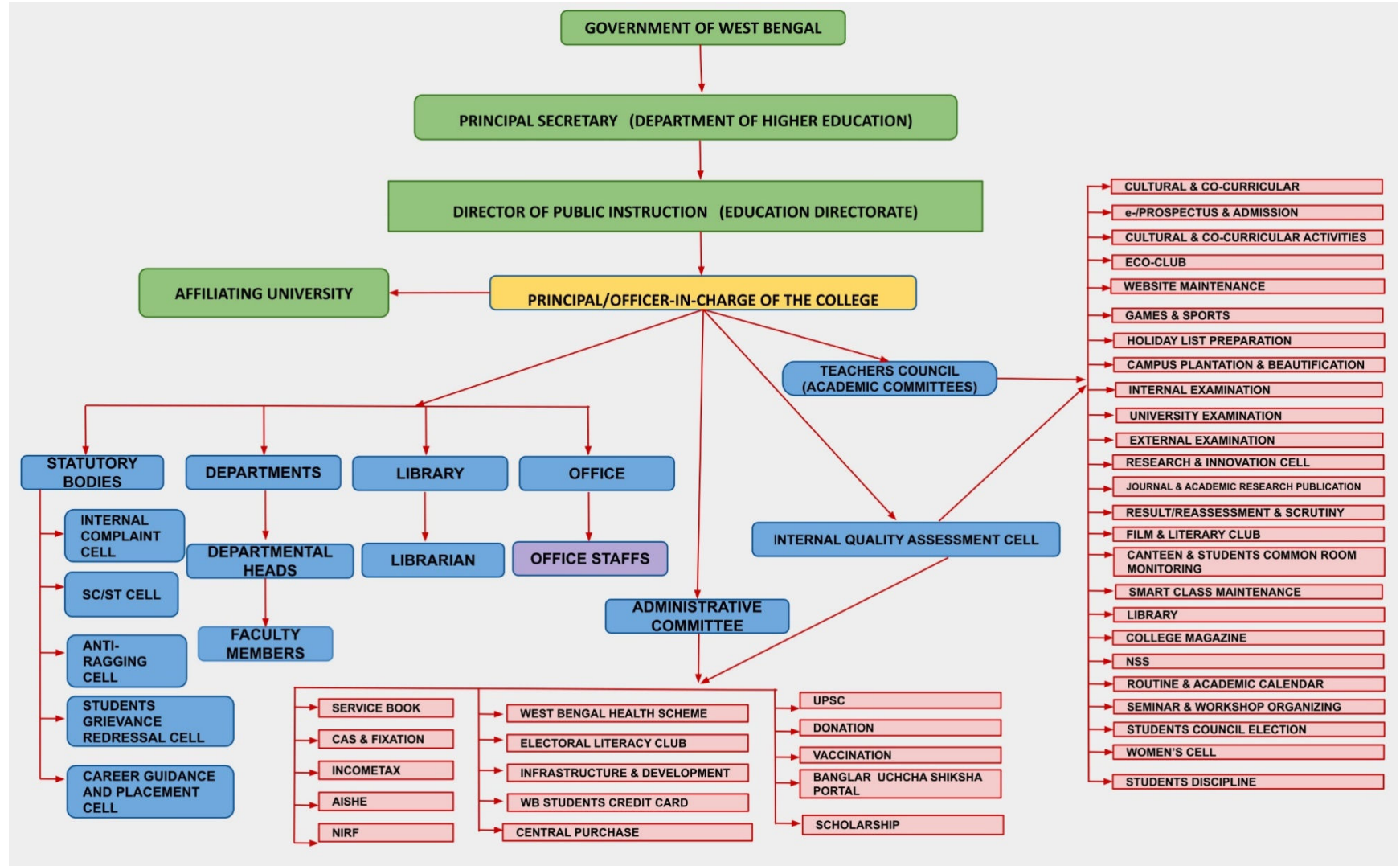

- a.
