Environmental Conservation and Community services by NSS:

The Social and environmental services provided by the National Service Scheme (NSS) of Gorubathan Government College has been pivotal in fostering community engagement and development, especially in rural and underserved areas of Gorubathan. For a rural college, NSS Unit-1 offers a valuable platform for students to contribute meaningfully to the local community, addressing unique challenges and leveraging local opportunities. 1. Conducted Community Assessments: NSS unit has been actively involved collecting and preserving data on socioeconomic and environmental conservation efforts of the local populace.
