Credit Point- Product of grade point and credit value of a course (G.P=5, C= 4 then, Credit Point = $5 \times 4 = 20$)

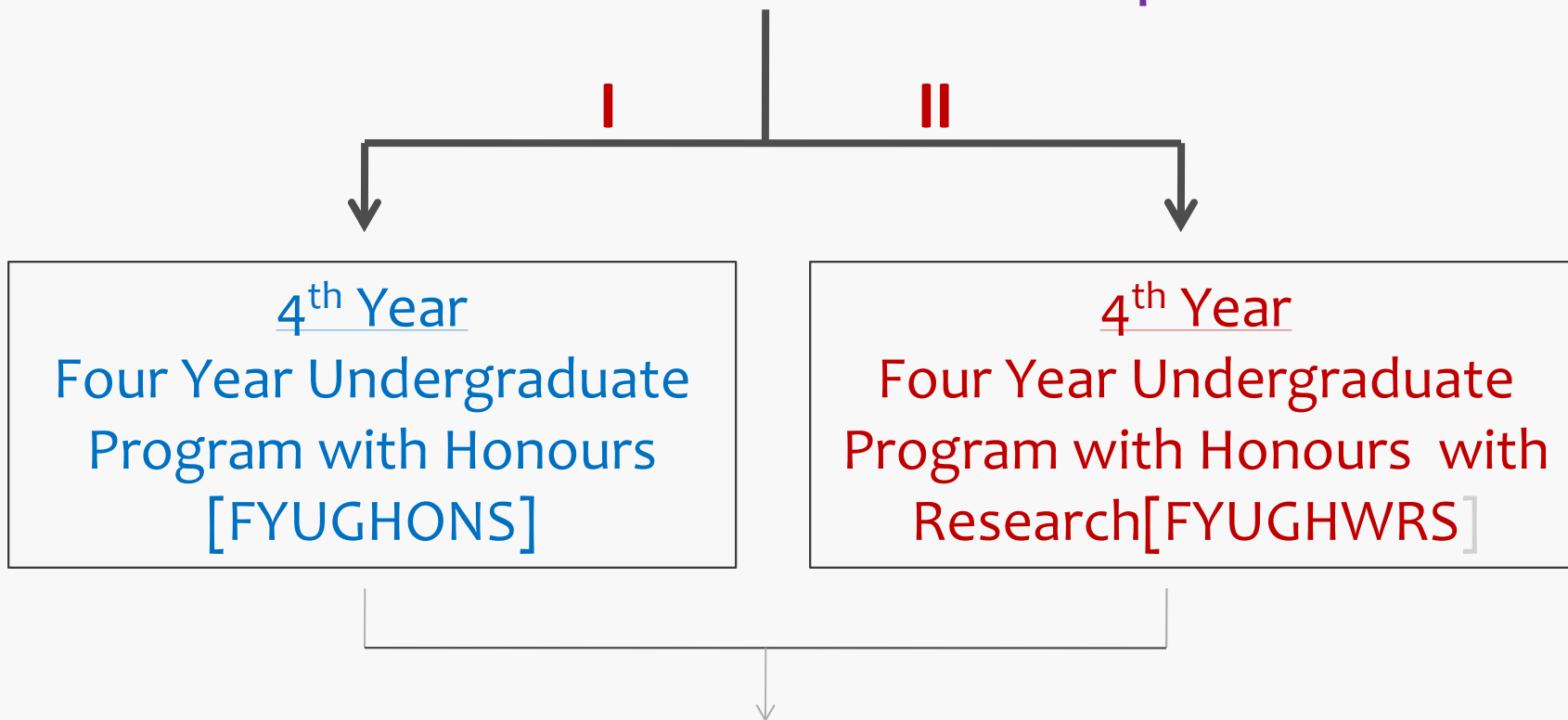

Session Break : Students who exit with undergraduate certificate or undergraduate diploma are permitted to re-enter within 3 years and complete the degree program. Total duration for completing 3 years is 5 years and that of 4 years UG course is 7 years but only after securing 124 credit (3 years)
