**ADMISSION GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION INTO DIFFERENT COURSES OF FOUR
YEARS GRADUATE PROGRAM (FYUGP) FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2022-2023**

**(Students who have passed H.S. or equivalent examinations in 2021, 2022,
2023 are eligible to apply)**

Applicants are advised to follow following instructions during online admission process.

1. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

General eligibility criteria

A student will be allowed to take admission in the Major Course of B.A./B.Sc. if he/she/transgender has passed in at least four (04) subjects with English as compulsory subject in the Higher Secondary [10+2] Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other Examination which is recognized by the University as equivalent thereto.

Admission will be on merit and availability of seats, provided that for SC/ST Candidates, the minimum marks for eligibility will be as per rules of the State Government.

Provided however that:

i. A candidate will be allowed to take up any subject except Computer Science, Microbiology, and such other interdisciplinary subjects in B.A./B.Sc. FYUG Program, if he/she/transgender has passed in the corresponding subject (s) at the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) recognized as equivalent by the University.

ii. A candidate will be allowed to take up Botany/Zoology Subject if he/she/transgender has passed in Biology at the qualifying examination.

iii. A candidate will be allowed to take up Economics as if he/she/transgender has passed in Mathematics or Applied Mathematics or Business Economics including Business Mathematics, and other subjects as prescribed at the qualifying examination.

iv. No student other than those of Science stream and Economics/Geography of Arts stream will be allowed to take Science subjects as Minor Subjects.

v. No student of Arts and Commerce stream other than those of Geography and Economics will be allowed to take Science subjects as Minor Subjects.

vi. A candidate pursuing Major in a subject will not be allowed to take up the same subject as Minor.

vii. A candidate pursuing Major in a Language subject will be allowed to take another Language subject as a Minor Subject.

viii. A candidate pursuing Major in Economics will be awarded B.Sc. Major if he/she/ transgender choose any one subject (Mathematics/ Statistics/ Computer Science) as Minor, or else he/she/transgender will be awarded B.A. Major.

Merit calculation

- For a Major course, **where student has studied the subject at +2 level** – Marks obtained in Major/related subject + Marks obtained in English + Best marks obtained in other two subjects.
- For a Major course, **where student has not studied the subject at +2 level** – Marks obtained in English + Best marks obtained in other three subjects.

Note: A candidate will be allowed to pursue a maximum of Three Year under a Major Course if he/she/transgender have passed the qualifying Examination in Vocational Stream subject.

OTHER REGULATIONS

Reservation of Seats: There will be reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/ Differently Able Candidates as per Government Rules. For differently-able candidates' minimum disability at least 40% will be considered.

Session Gap: For admission to the Undergraduate Program there should not be a gap of more than 3 years between the year of Higher Secondary Examination and the year of admission to Undergraduate Program of study.

How to apply-

Candidates can register themselves for the admission to B.A./B.Sc. Major course by accessing to admission portal of the college i.e. www.gorubathangdc.co.in. Upon clicking the “Apply Online” link on the admission portal, the candidates will be asked to register themselves by signing up with their personal details. Apart from their personal details, candidates will be asked to furnish their academic details and other related information. They must upload the scanned copy of their photograph (size between 30-50 KB) and other academics related documents (size between 30-50 KB). Subsequently, student should fill the required academic details to complete the registration process.

Payment Details-

Candidates can make stipulated fee through net banking, credit card and ATM cum debit card. No physical submission of payment will be accepted.

Credentials required-

Candidates are required to upload scanned copy of following credentials-

- I. 10+2 mark sheet
- II. 10 admit card or Birth Certificate
- III. Caste certificate if applicable
- IV. PWD certificate if applicable
- v. EWS certificate if applicable

Note: Candidates cannot claim to be reserved candidates unless the picture (online) or self-attested photocopy (during verification) of the certificate is submitted.

Verification-

Admitted candidates must furnish Original set of Certificates mentioned below with a set of self-attested testimonials during verification at college.

- Printed copy of duly filled and signed application form
- Two passport size photograph (colour)
- Migration Certificate for all the board except for WBCHSE
- School leaving Certificate or Transfer Certificate from respective school
- Higher Secondary Mark Sheet

- Higher Secondary Pass Certificate
- Madhyamik Admit Card/ Certificate or Age Proof Certificate
- Student's Caste/PWD/EWS Certificate from appropriate authority as per Govt. Rule.
- Anti-ragging affidavit duly signed by candidate and his/her parent/guardian.

Physical attendance in class for verification of testimonials on stipulated dates (after making payments) is mandatory, otherwise his/her candidature will be cancelled. In any case, due to an emergency (*viz.*, Hospitalization, etc.) the candidate could not appear in classes for verification of testimonials on the stipulated dates, his/her authorized representatives may appear with all original testimonials and candidates' medical certificate or related supporting documents.

****The Candidate has to submit cancellation certificate at the time of verification of testimonials, if he/she was already admitted in another college.**
